PROVISIONS FOR ELDERS

Covid has impacted the lives of many vulnerable elders in the North of Sri Lanka. These elders are either abandoned by their children or have no one to look after them. Often they only have one meal a day. We initiated this project 14 months ago (June-2020). We provide dry rations to over 150 elders by-monthly. To feed an elder it costs us £8/month. Sadly, some of the poorer students are unable to benefit as they do not have the ability to connect. Serendip has however been able to fund connections for some students within parts of Mullithivu & Kilinochchi.
