
Jaffna. Many of our beneficiaries were met to discuss the results of our support

Our projects for orphans and other vulnerable children range from pre-school education (including the training of teachers), IT courses (laptops supplied), Remedial (extra) classes and education in general.

Some of our secondary assistance involves the funding of day trips and treats, sports meetings, and sometimes medical operations for disabled and ill children.
