





AUTISM (update)

As reported in an earlier newsletter we sent a panel of seven teachers/health professionals to India (Chennai) to receive an intensive one month training in Special needs, particularly on autism.

More recently, Serendip has joined with a local group of Medical and Non-medical professionals (including those from the health department) to help create **Autism policy** on the Island. Thus, one of its' joint ongoing projects is to develop such a policy document for Autism. The draft policy was launched in July in Jaffna. It is estimated that it will take two years to complete the development of the policy before it can be implemented.

We are also working on a new initiative where a trained group of professionals will assess children with Special Needs and then issue a **Statement of Education** (a document explaining a child's medical condition). The Statement is also a document which sets out a child's special educational needs (SEN) and any additional help that the child should receive. The ultimate aim of the Statement is to make sure that the child gets the right support that will enable them to make progress in school.
