# **GIVING IN MOTION**

Although Serendip runs some long standing projects we are always looking for new schemes to support. These are just some of our latest initiatives.

## SUPPORT TO PRE-SCHOOLS!

D CURRENT EVENTS

We support over 15 pre-schools with teachers payments, school equipment and 'breakfast for kids'.

The latter project of providing a nutritional breakfast to kids in pre-school is one of our most important.

For example, a recent addition is Nanadam in the Mannar District, which contains 34 pre-schools. Serendip is already supporting 5 of these but has been asked to help a further 7. To do so we need more funds. Each school looks after 15-30 children and the cost for Serendip would be £500-600 per year.

The children come from very poor backgrounds and usually have only one meal per day and rarely is it a breakfast.

## **PROGRESSION IN FINE ARTS**

We have two established Fine Art Centers on the island. Over 150 students are learning miruthangam, dance, violin and vocal. We are planning to open a third center in Manner as there are growing demands in that district for such an education.





#### **Helping Special Need Children & Autism**

We are providing speech therapy to some of the existing Centres for Special Needs Children. We also pay the transport expenses to those who cannot otherwise afford to attend the Centres and pay the salaries of about 8 teachers in these centers. We are now focusing on helping a further two schools.

#### **ONE-OFF PROJECTS**

Although we regularly assist long-standing projects we often make one-off payments to 'good causes'. For example, helping families whose main breadwinner is disabled, digging/repairing tube wells, Water tanks in schools to secure clean water, and laptops/PC's for Primary schools.
