EMERGENCY APPEAL

Most of you will be aware of Sri Lanka's current dire economic situation. The more serious impact on the ground is the exorbitant rise in the price of food and increasing shortages, including fuel.

Everyone is suffering, particularly single parent households and especially vulnerable elders are among the worst affected. Although Serendip clearly can't help everyone, we do aim to provide dry food rations to some of the most vulnerable in the north & east of the Island. One of these groups are the island's elders.

DRY FOOD DELIVERY TO ELDERS

Sadly, their need is huge since in every region we work within we have identified a very large number of, effectively, abandoned elders. So far, every two months, we provide a dry food package to selected elders.

Presently, we are already helping 210 elders, but we have twice of that amount still awaiting our help!

LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT



One of Serendip's ongoing projects is to support families (mainly those with school going children), who have to live on lower incomes or even no income, to generate additional revenue. We are presently helping 5-6 families of women-headed households per month.

There are also a significant number of such families that have the added challenge of caring for a child with a physical disability or with special needs. Since the mothers cannot leave home to earn money, we aim to provide financial support to create home-based businesses e.g. small shops, livestock's, home gardening etc. This will cost around £200 per business. BREAKFAST FOR KIDS

The need for feeding preschool kids in some of the northern areas is growing as more and more school children arrive at school with empty stomachs. The lack of this nutrition negatively affects their concentration. The majority of them come from very poor families that are simply unable to afford the luxury of a breakfast. Unfortunately, many pupils are unable to afford to purchase the necessary materials.

Serendip identifies schools where predominantly the poorest of children study. We then provide educational materials to last a year. This improves the chances of those pupils prospering in their education and thus providing career opportunities which many rural children have been traditionally denied.
