# **GIVING IN MOTION**

Although Serendip runs some long standing projects we are always looking for new schemes to support. These are just some of our latest initiatives.



### WHO WE ARE?

The charity seeks to provide long term and selfsustainable assistance to the most destitute of families in the North & East of Sri Lanka. We particularly focus on women headed families and vulnerable children who are currently experiencing acute poverty and severe hardship. These problems are not being addressed by any agency of national or local government so therefore the work of Serendip is **crucial** if further suffering is to be avoided. We run many projects (we highlight just a few below). Any donation for which our beneficiaries would be most grateful.

#### LIVELIHOOD PROGRAMME

(Start up support for small businesses)

We particularly focus on women headed families with vulnerable children, who are currently experiencing acute poverty and severe hardship. To alleviate their condition and protect them from living off aid, we run a Livelihood programme, which aims to fund 'start-up' businesses, primarily via self-employment.

## AUTISM & ADHD

As part of our ongoing SPECIAL NEEDS project, we are now providing specialist facilities, therapy, and equipment to SN units (particularly in deprived areas) to support children with autism and other special needs. This includes sensory rooms, speech & language, music & dance therapies, and yoga sessions, in our Fine Arts centres (which we physically run).

#### **BUILDING A SMALL HOME**

Serendip has launched a new project (building a small/modest size home) in response to repeated requests. In particular, Elders who have no place to live and no means of support and mothers who have been abandoned by their husbands, need help! This would consist of building a small home, e.g., a one-bedroom home, to replace the shacks many have to live in.

The below pictures highlight our first constructed home. A similar home would cost between  $\pounds$ 1,300- $\pounds$ 1,500. Can you help?

#### **BRINGING WATER TO THE PEOPLE!**

So many families in numerous villages throughout the north & East, and Central part of the Island have no access to drinking water. Every day they will walk miles to collect water in buckets. We build small common wells or repair existing ones. On average around 50 families benefit from one well.

\* The cost of one well is £350 (the cost of the tank, piping and labour). To bring water however from the mountain springs to houses in the bottom of the mountain cost us £1200-1400. Can you help? If so contact us via info@serendipchildrenshome. com
