BRINGING CLEAN WATER TO VILLAGES

In the hill country regions like Badulla, Matara, and Monaragala, the daily task of collecting water is a significant challenge for villagers. To address this, we're constructing water tanks, distribution lines, and collection points, transforming the effort to **access clean water** into a simpler, more manageable task. IMPROVING SHELTER

(for Sri Lanka's Tea Plantation Workers)

In the hill country of central Sri Lanka, tea plantation workers live in huts with worn-out tin roofs. These roofs often fail during the rainy season, making the houses nearly uninhabitable. We're working to replace and repair these roofs.

So far, we've helped over 50 families, but many more need our support. The cost for each roof is around £150-£175. Your donations, whether for one roof or multiple, can make a **significant difference** in providing secure and dry homes for these workers. **Interested?** (see below)
