LATEST PROJECTS

Valvoom Meendum

Apart from our long standing Care in the Community scheme our other existing project, the co-operative named 'Valvoom Meendum' (We rise again) making and selling stationary, candle and incense sticks on the open market, is giving 30 widowed women a livelihood and is going from strength to strength. Without your help these women would be living off handouts. Today they are self-sufficient and valued members of the community.

Another project, Putiya Paathai (New Route), aims to support start-up small businesses for widows. We have the funding in place and we are now actively looking for a partner in Sri Lanka.

School scholarships

We have begun to sponsor some scholarships for talented orphaned children. This will pay for

food, especially breakfast and books.

We are helping 20 children in Jaffna city, we are selecting a further 20 in Battlcaloa, and will turn our attention very soon to a similar number in the Mannar district.



Help for the suffering

Apart from natural causes there are a number of children now suffering with mental health issues due to the war. We have teamed up with a local organisation named Ark, based in Jaffna to supply them with funds to help 10 children.

Another group of sufferers are cancer affected children, often from a very poor background. As can be imagined the sort of treatment we may receive in the West, even in the Sri Lankan capital, Colombo, is far superior than anything these children can look forward too. Our help can give them a little happiness i.e. paying for days out and treats and a little hope.

Can you help?

As you can see we are actively trying to better the lives of children and widows rather than simply complaining and bemoaning their plight. If we don't try and help who will?
