PROJECT REPORTS

Two of our projects joined forces recently to hold a Sports Day for the children cared for in our Care in the Community programme. After the events the children and their mothers gathered in the Valwom Meedum building for a get together.

The Putiya Paathai (New Route) is soon to begin its work, providing the finance for small start-up businesses for widows, before Xmas. The widows are being selected from two areas; Pooneraian and

Kaddaikadu in the Wanni.

A similar scheme in a different area is being considered and we will on progress in the next newsletter. The thirty cancer affected children received our help to cover treats for one year. This will be repeated next year. The children suffering with mental health issues are being helped on a monthly basis until further notice.
